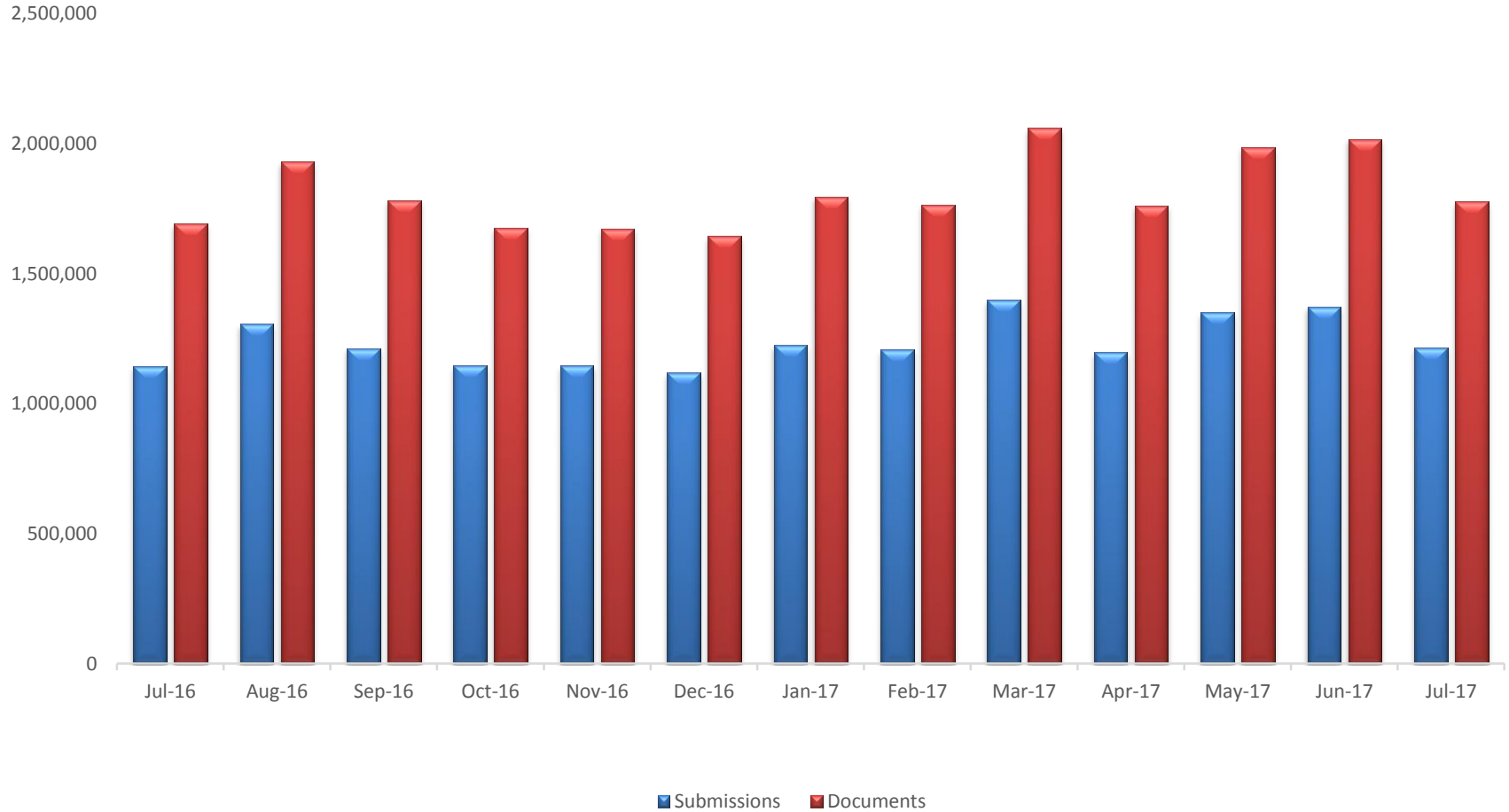

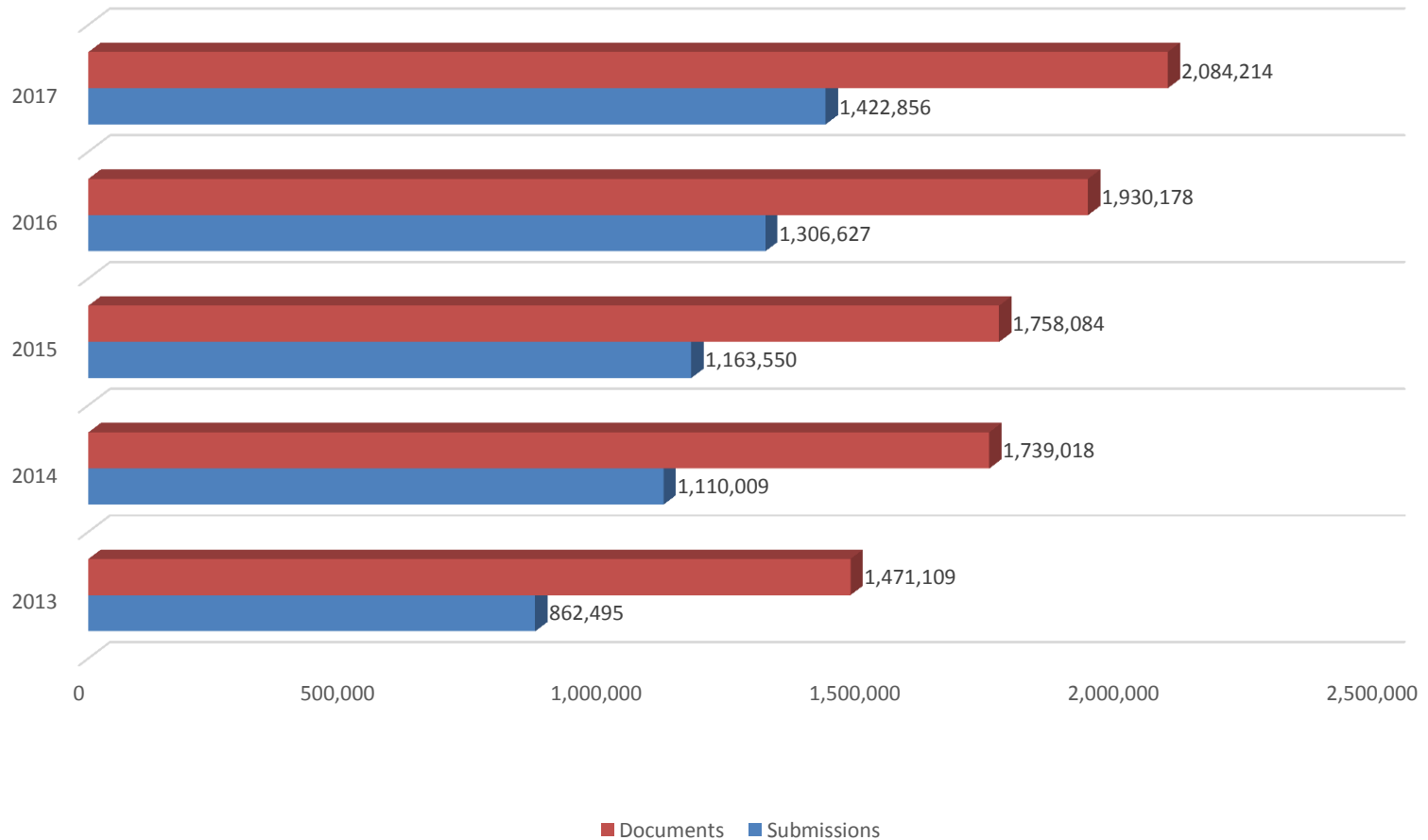


Year at a Glance



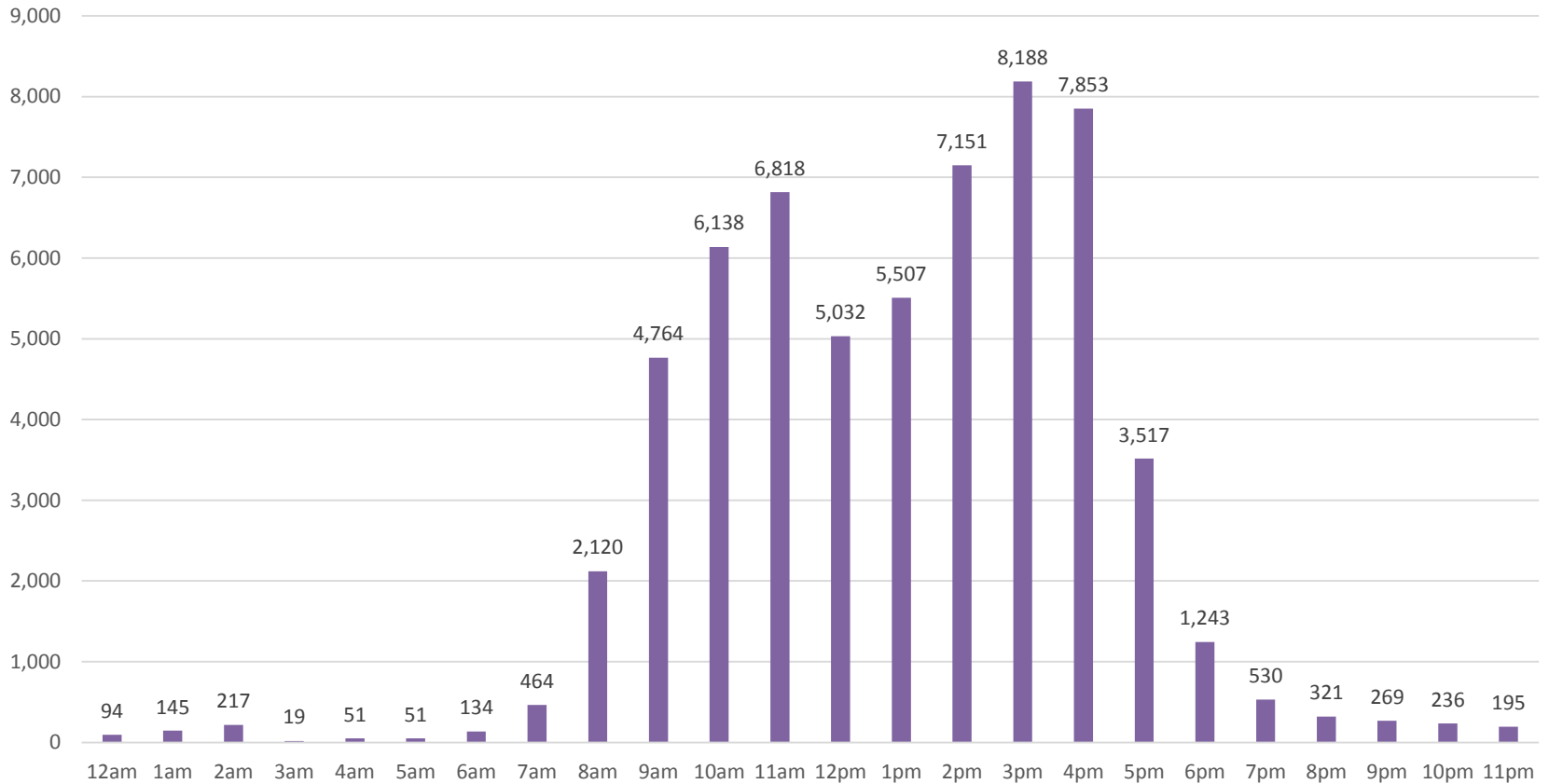


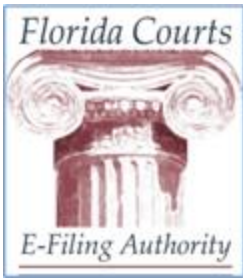
Aug. E-Filing Past 5 Years



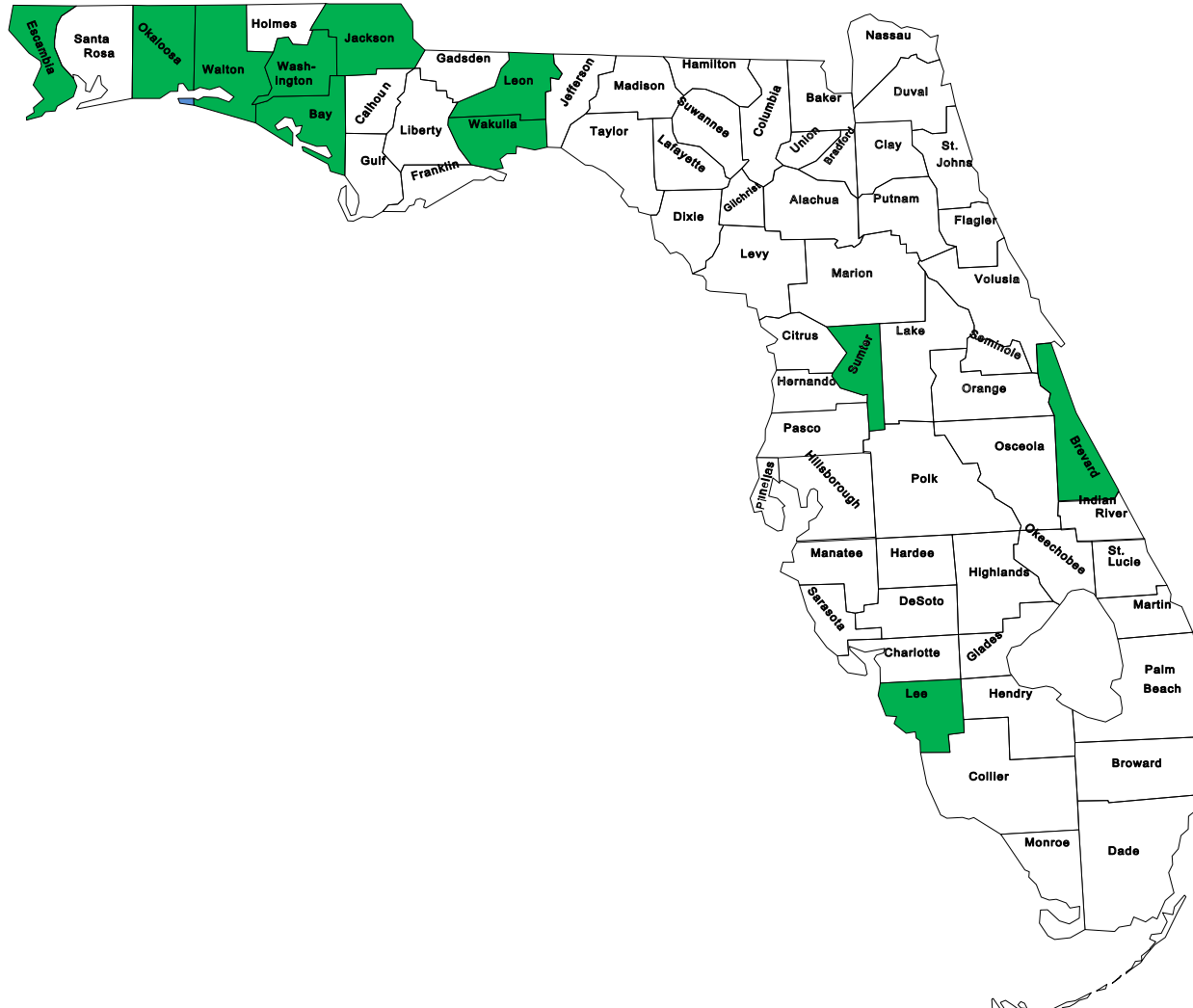


Average # Filings Per Hour





Accepting Proposed Orders via Portal



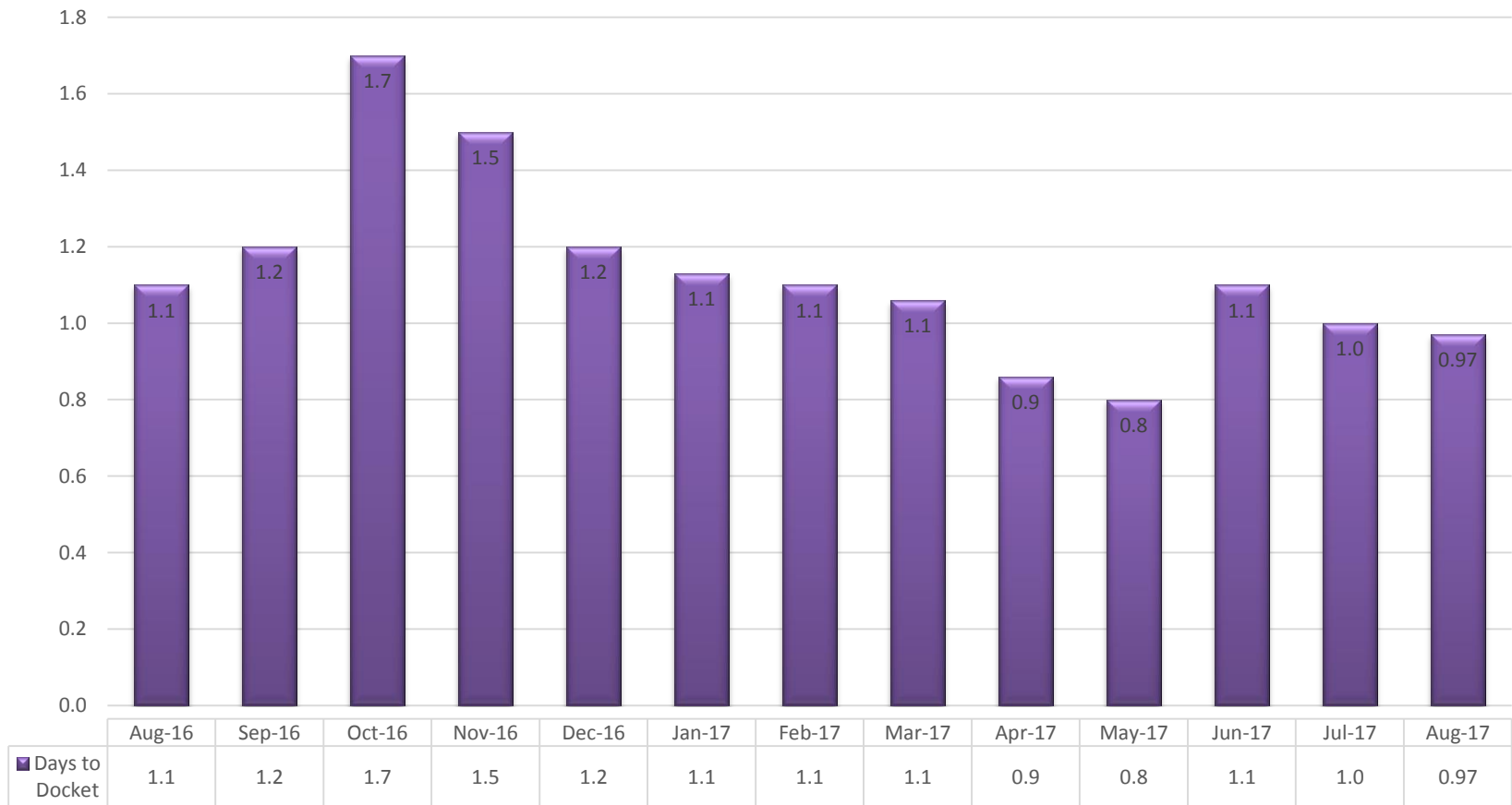

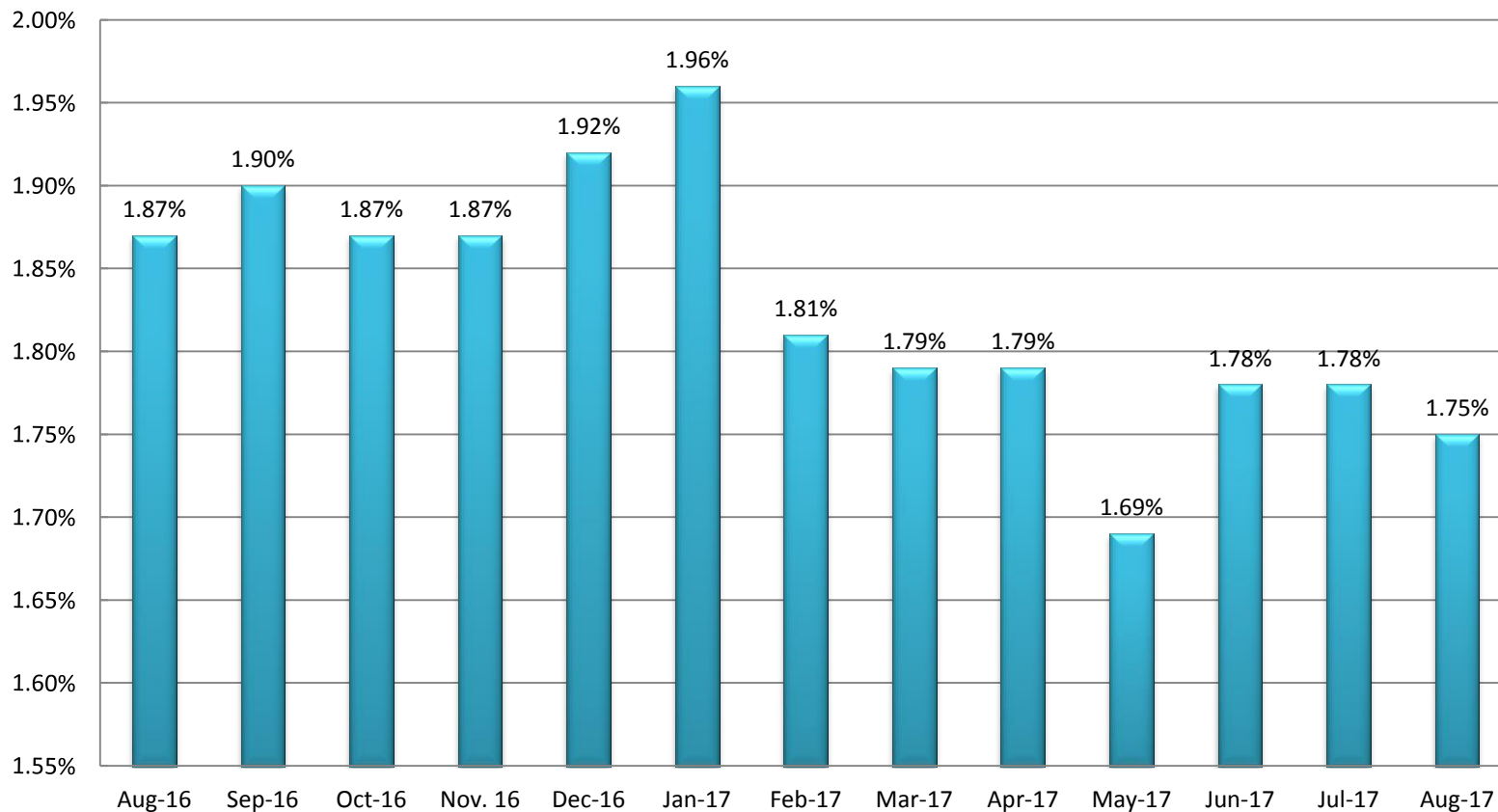


Average # Days to Docket

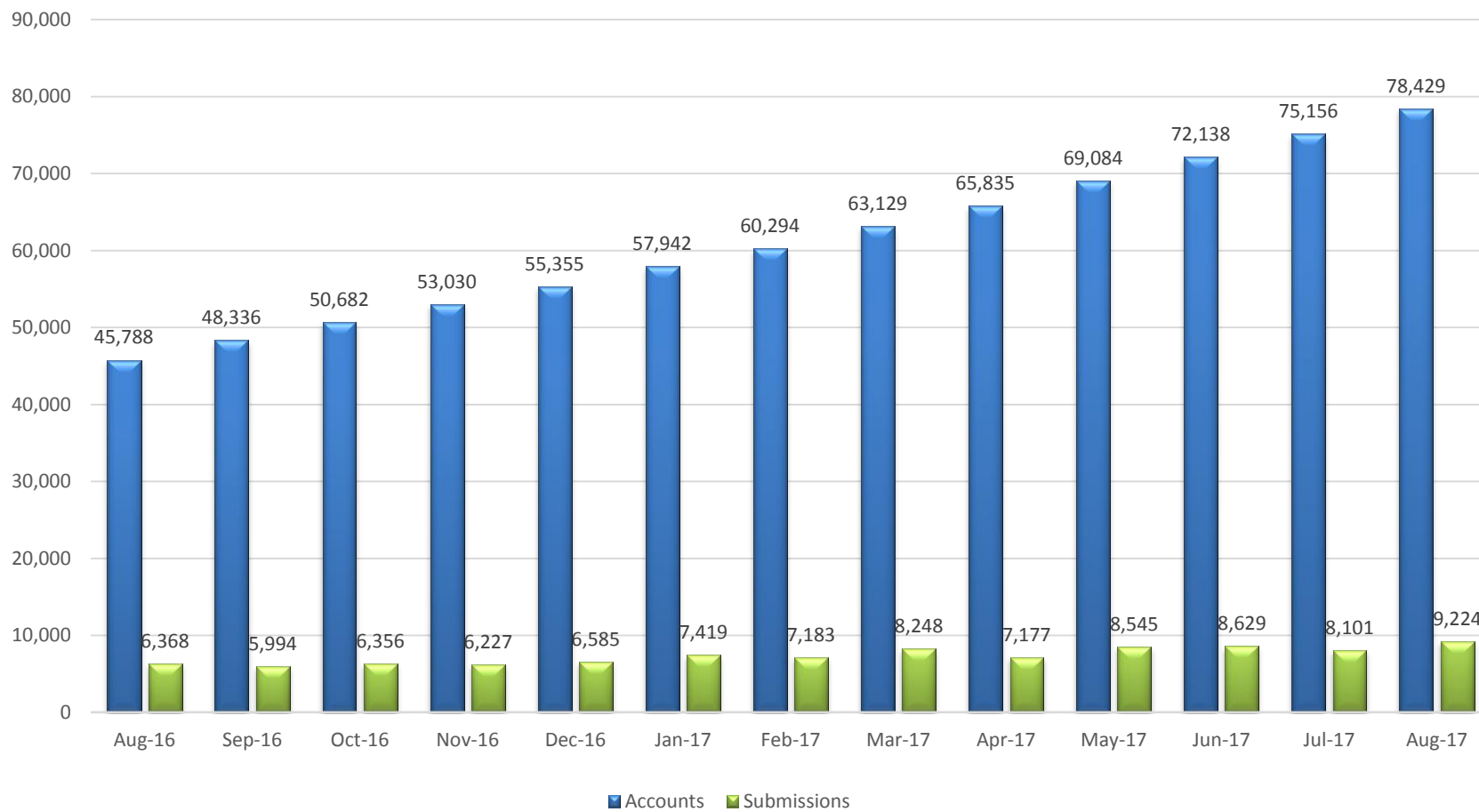
