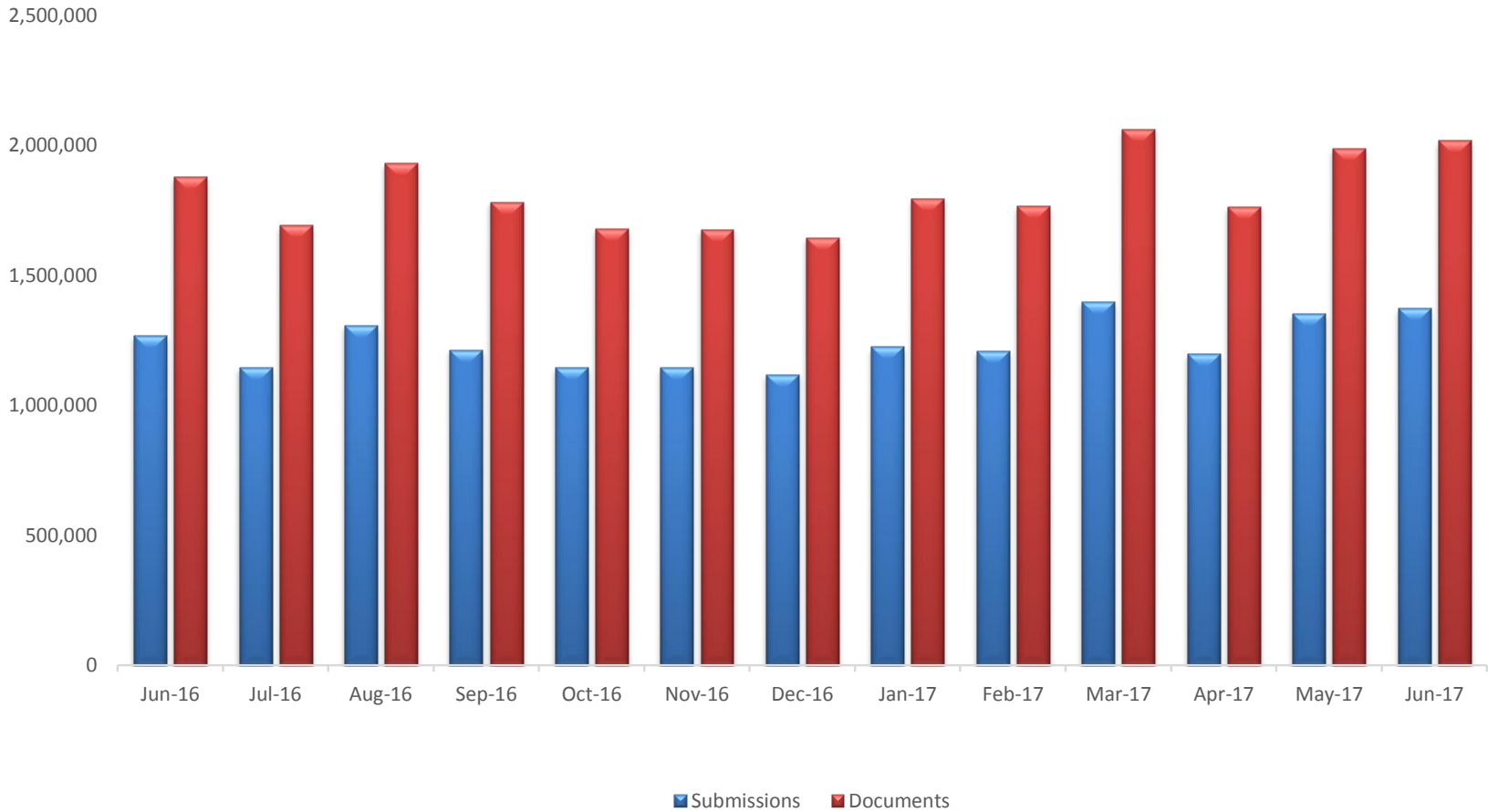

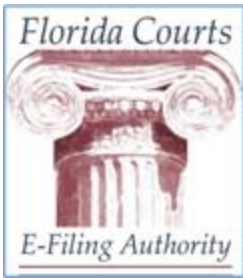

Year at a Glance





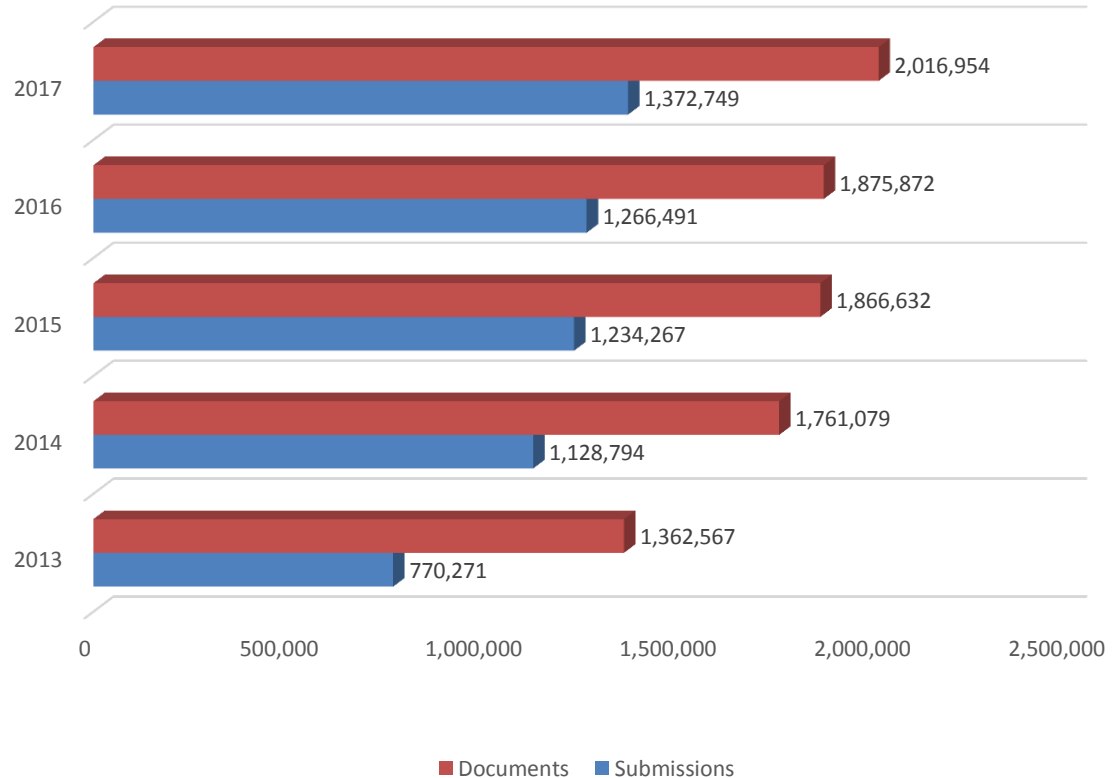
June E-Filing Past 5 Years

2014 – 2015 = 9.34% >

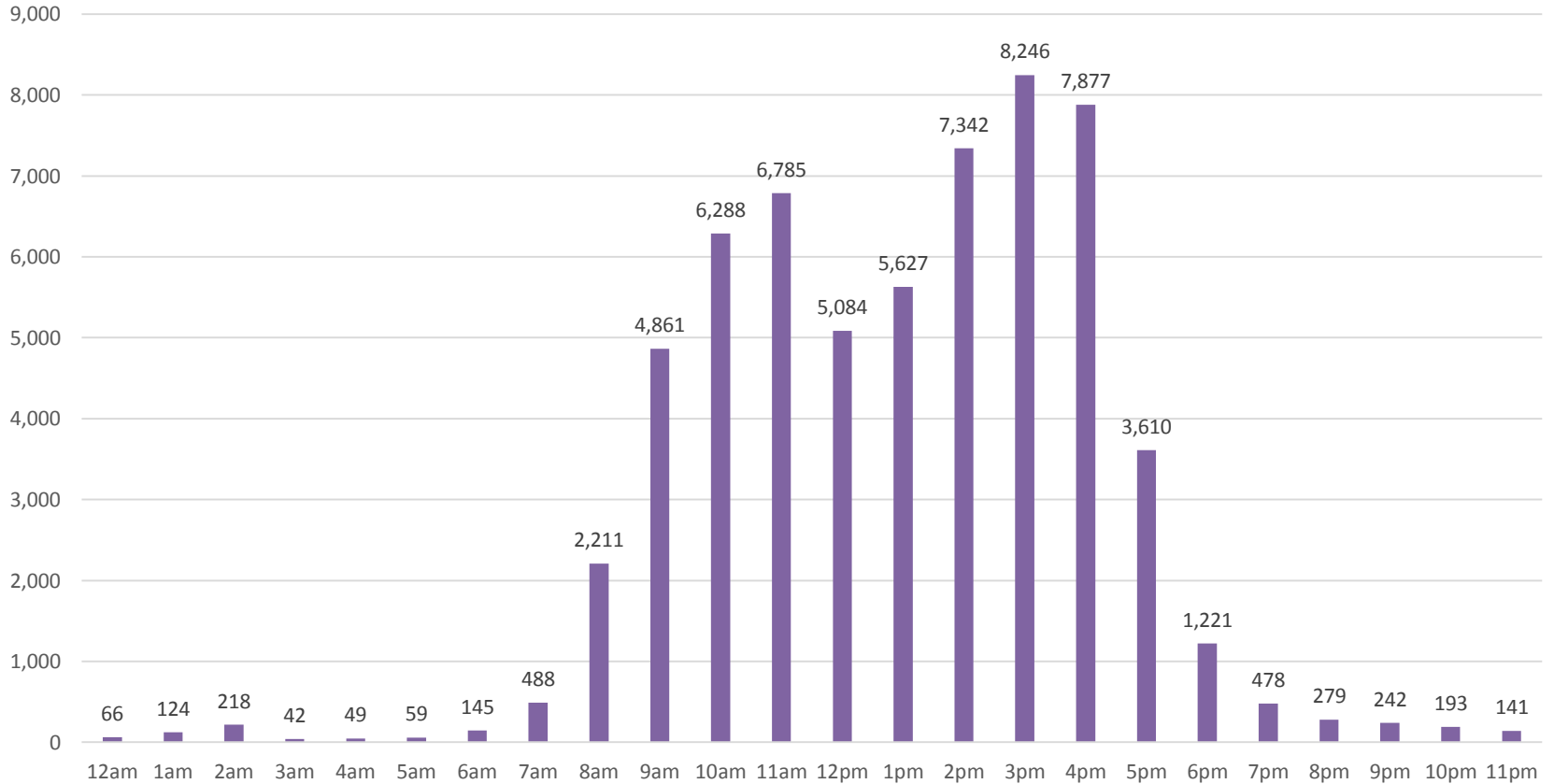

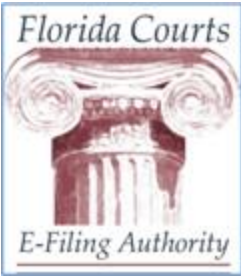


Civil E-Filing Mandatory April 2013
Criminal E-Filing Mandatory October 2013

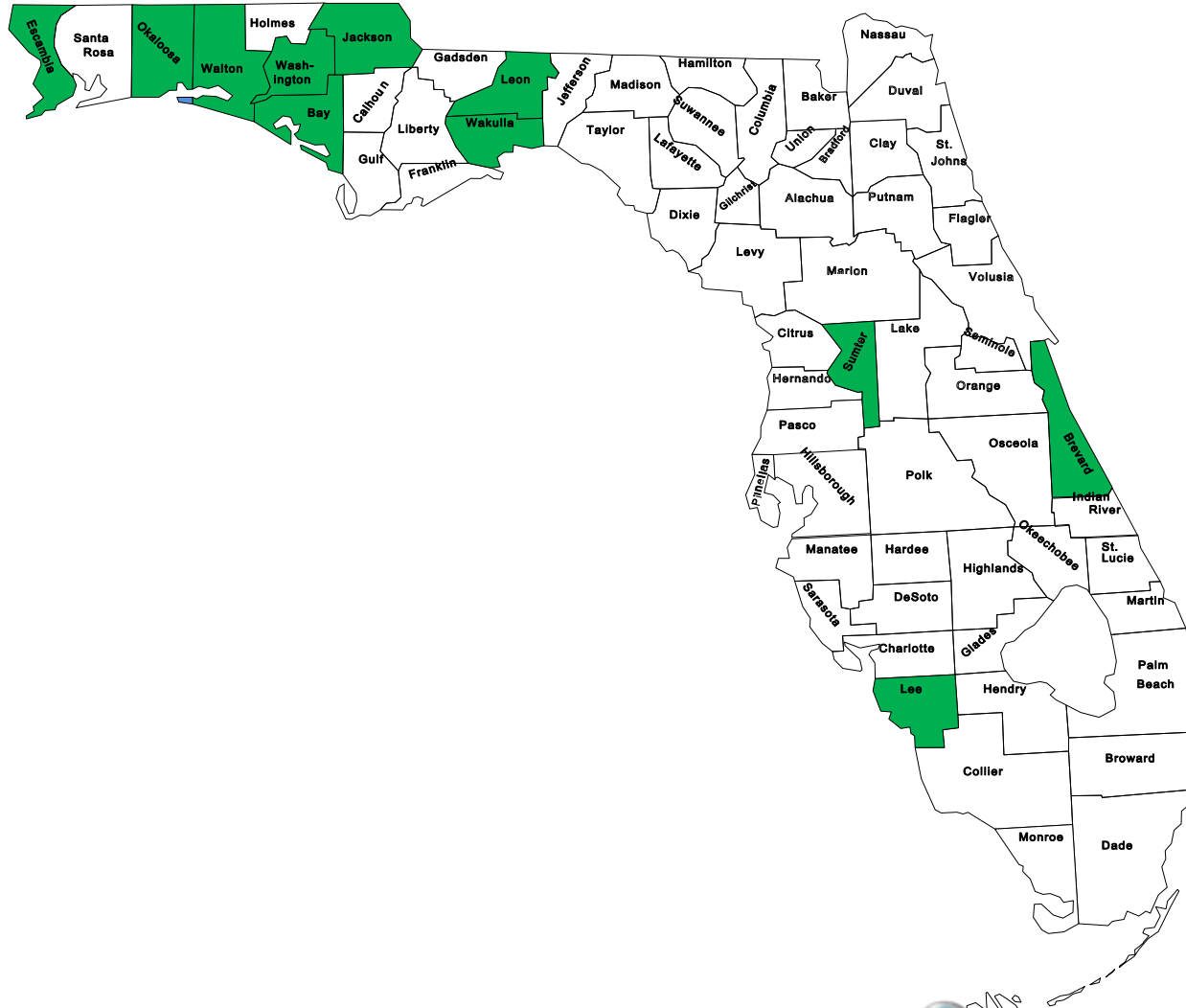


Filings Per Hour





Accepting Proposed Orders via Portal



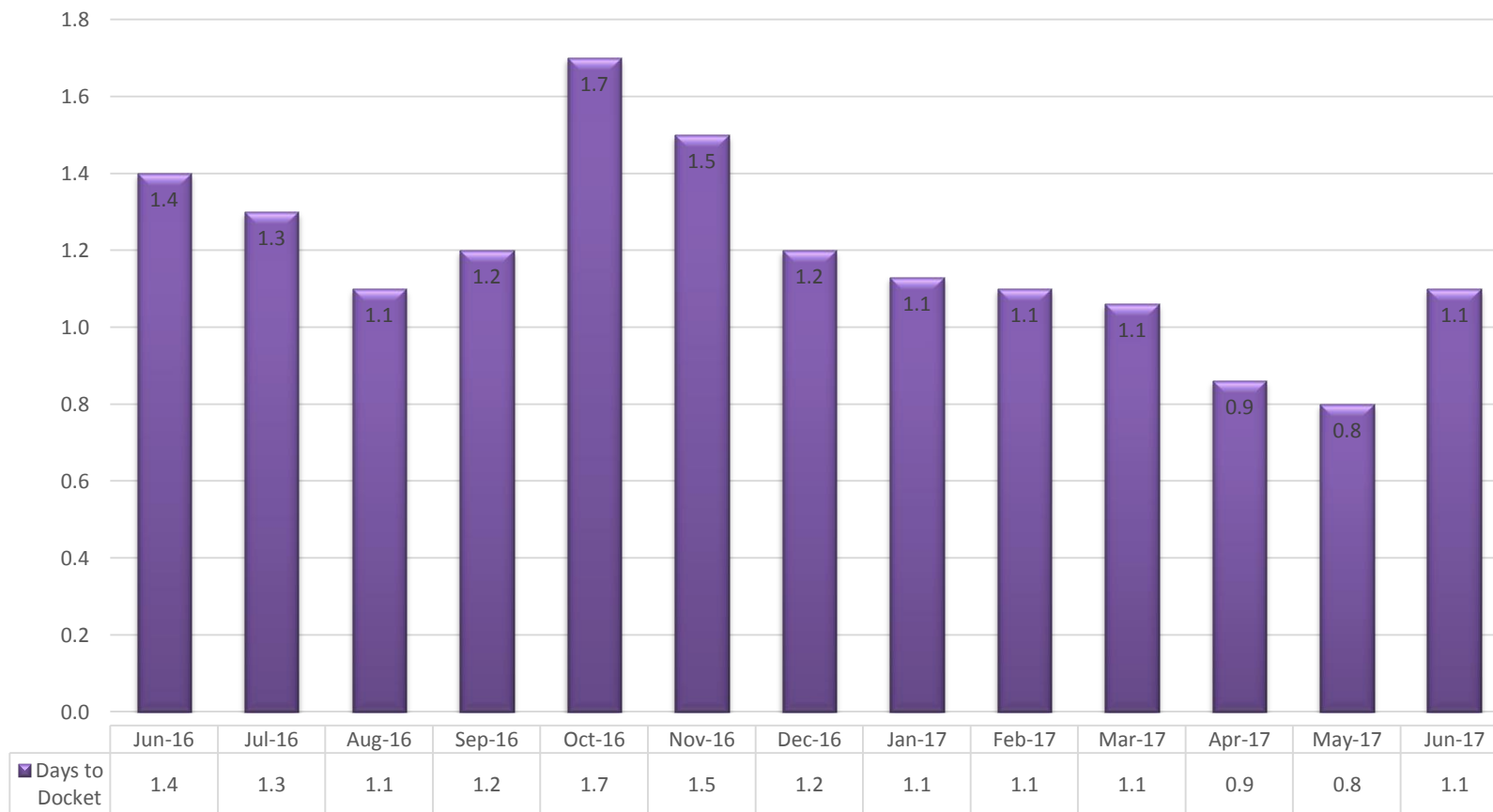


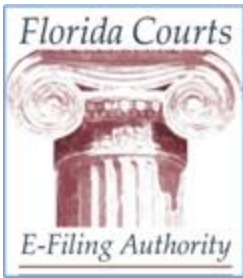

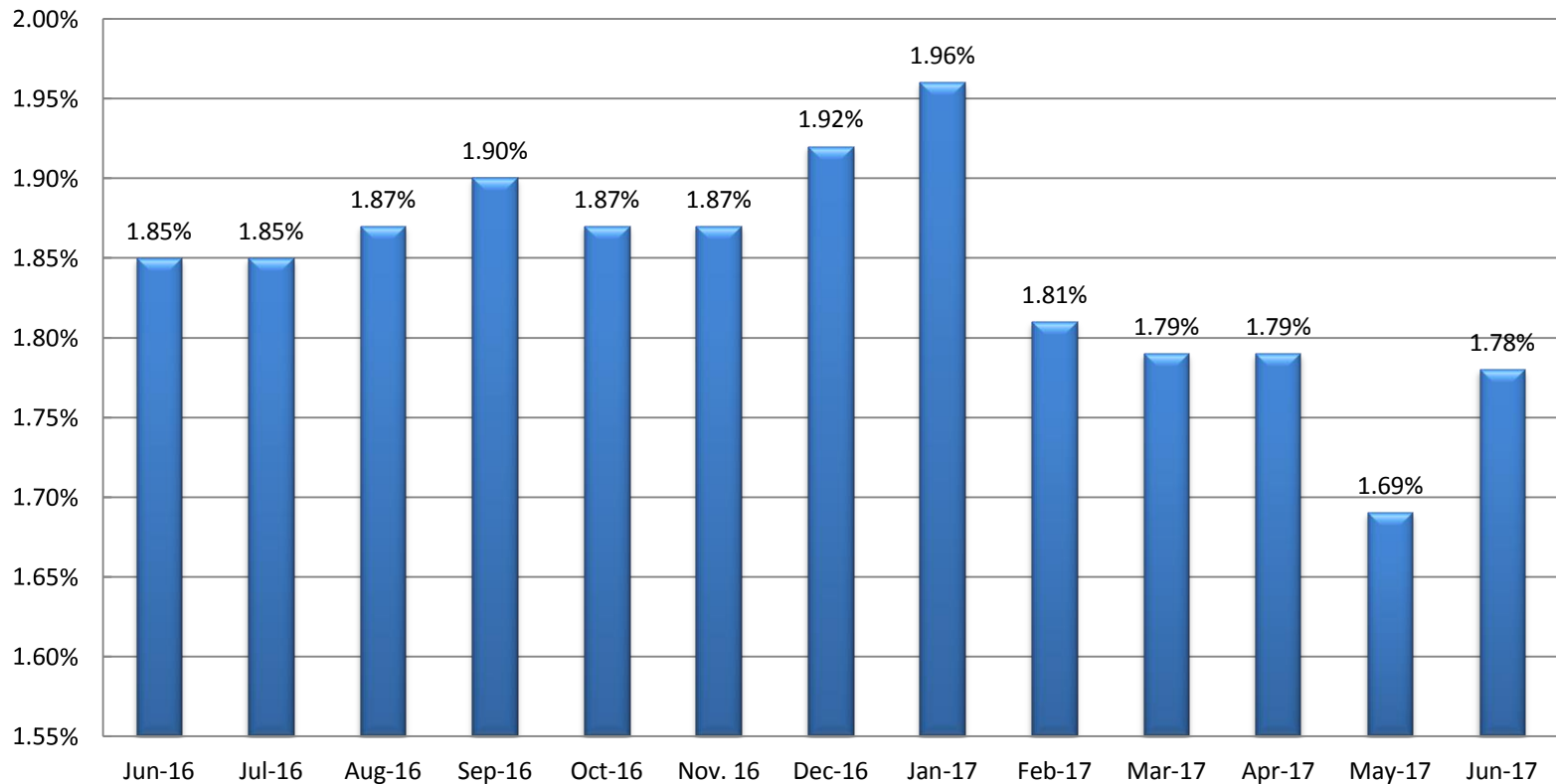


Average # Days to Docket
