The Volusia County Clerk of the Circuit Court has successfully completed testing and is now receiving batch eFiling in the criminal divisions from the State Attorney and the Public Defender for the Seventh Judicial Circuit. We have been accepting voluntary single session eFiling from private attorneys in the criminal divisions for several months now.

As required by Florida Supreme Court Administrative Order 13-48, I hereby notify the eFiling Authority that our office is accepting and receiving batch interface criminal eFilings on the live ePortal. The date that electronic filing shall become mandatory in all criminal divisions in Volusia County shall be **Monday, February 3, 2014**.

We commend the offices of the State Attorney and Public Defender in the 7th Judicial Circuit for meeting the deadline for batch eFiling readiness. We look forward to the efficiency and cost-saving rewards the justice community will realize from these efforts.
