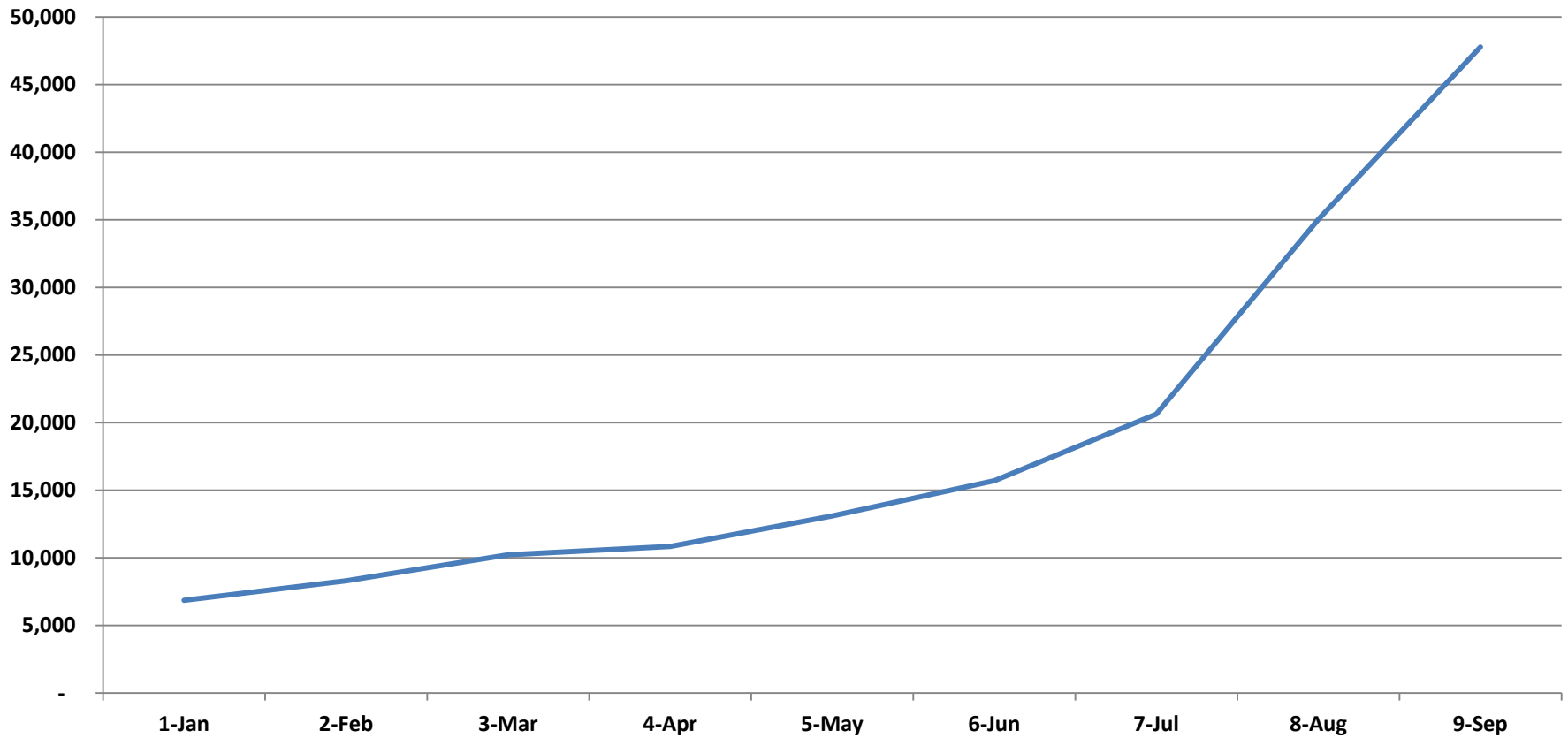

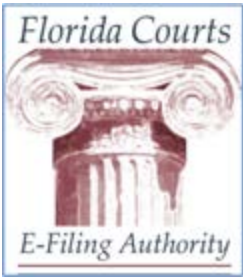


The Florida Courts ePortal 2012 Usage Statistics

2012 YTD eFilings by Month

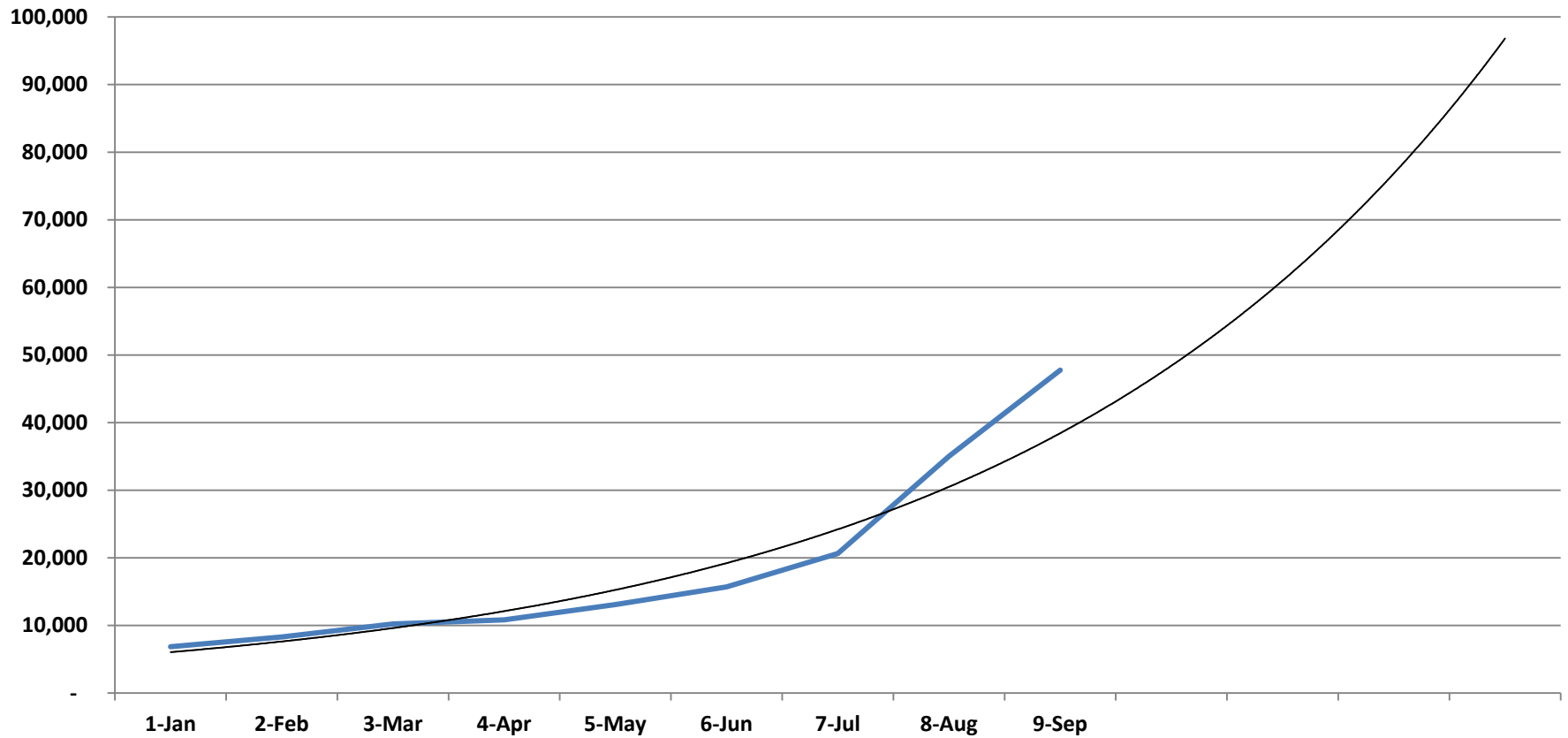


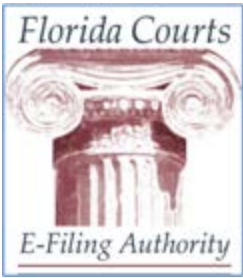

Projections Through January 2013

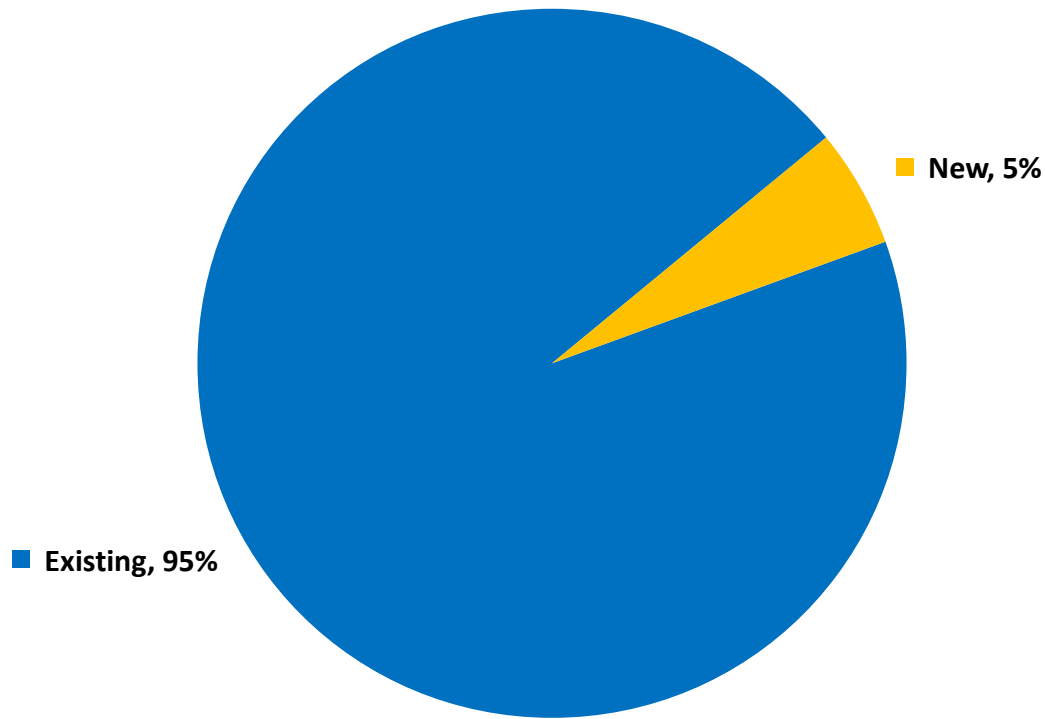


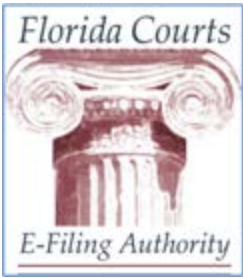

eFilings by Type of Case

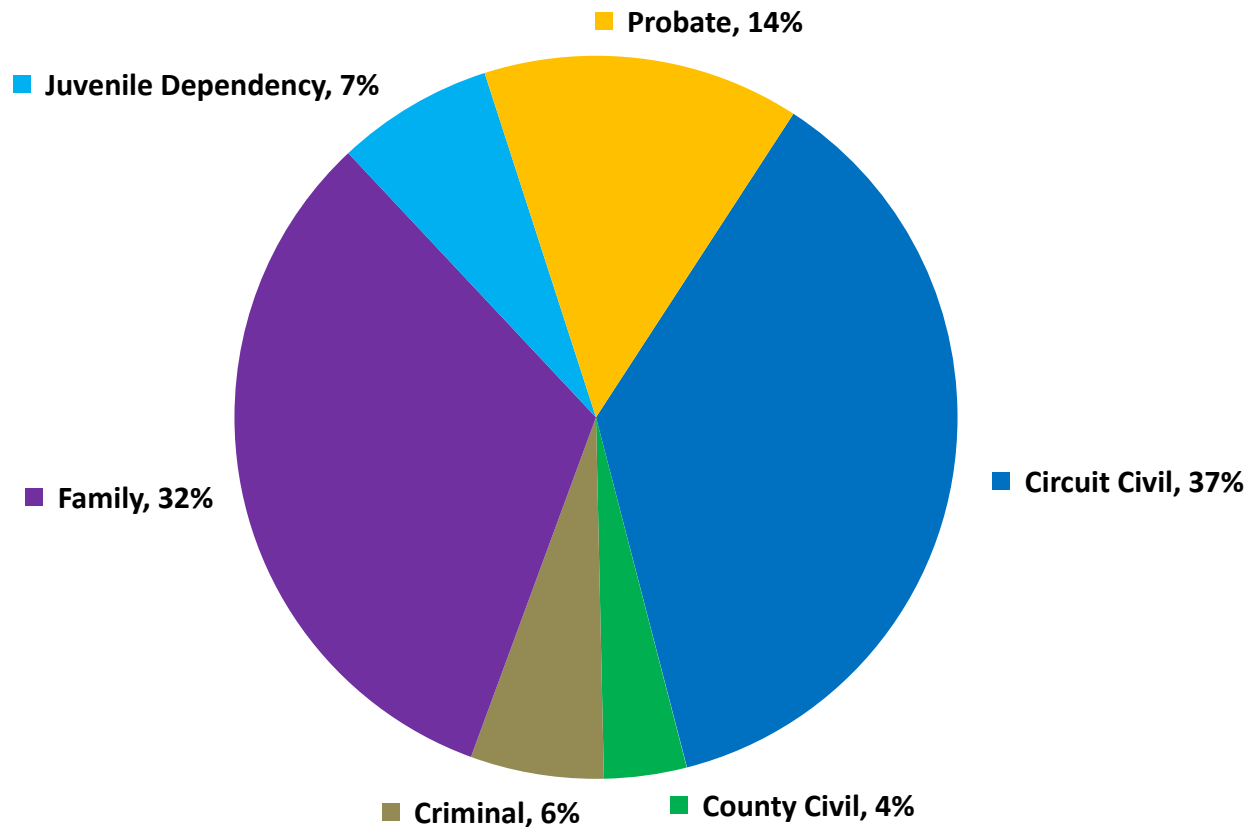

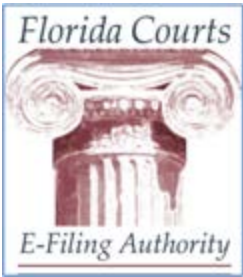

Criminal Update

- The ePortal is fully implemented and capable of receiving eFilings on Existing Criminal cases
- Collier, Lake, Santa Rosa, and Walton are currently accepting Single Session Criminal eFilings through the ePortal
- Progress continues in the collaborative effort between the State Attorneys, Public Defenders, and the FCCC to develop, test, and implement bulk eFiling via the Criminal Batch Interface
- 12 prospective county clerks offices have been identified for the Criminal Pilot Program and are currently determining if State Attorney and Public Defender counterparts in their circuit will be able to participate in testing and live eFiling verification for Existing Criminal cases
