Attached are the PD responses you requested. After listening to the dialogue at the emergency meeting, we feel it is very important to include our tab on the information provided to the Authority. We have many circuits who fall in the category of being technically capable of single session on Oct 1, but due to various issues, are still seeking a deferral. Our electeds want to make sure this information is known by the Authority, as it shows all are acting under the best of intentions. I dropped in our tab on the spreadsheet that is attached.

Second, our circuits also made it absolutely clear that E-Service MUST be deferred with E-Filing, for those circuits seeking a deferral. The FPDA has been vocal that we must have those two dates (e-filing and e-service) operating together. We filed comments to that effect, and it appears the Court listened when they moved the criminal dates for both to be Oct. 1.

We greatly appreciate all of the hard work your staff has provided on helping us get to this important date. We're in the home stretch.
