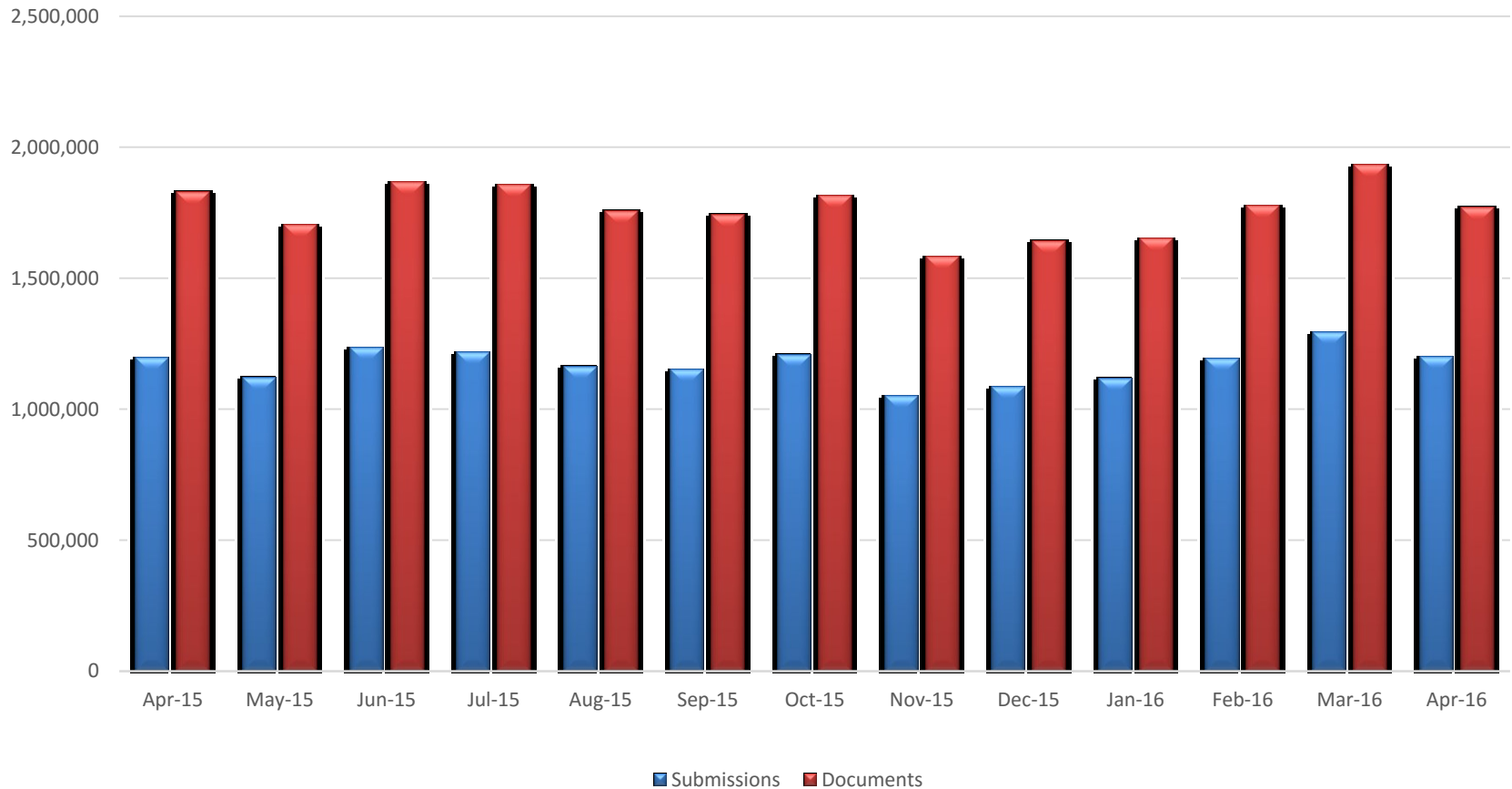

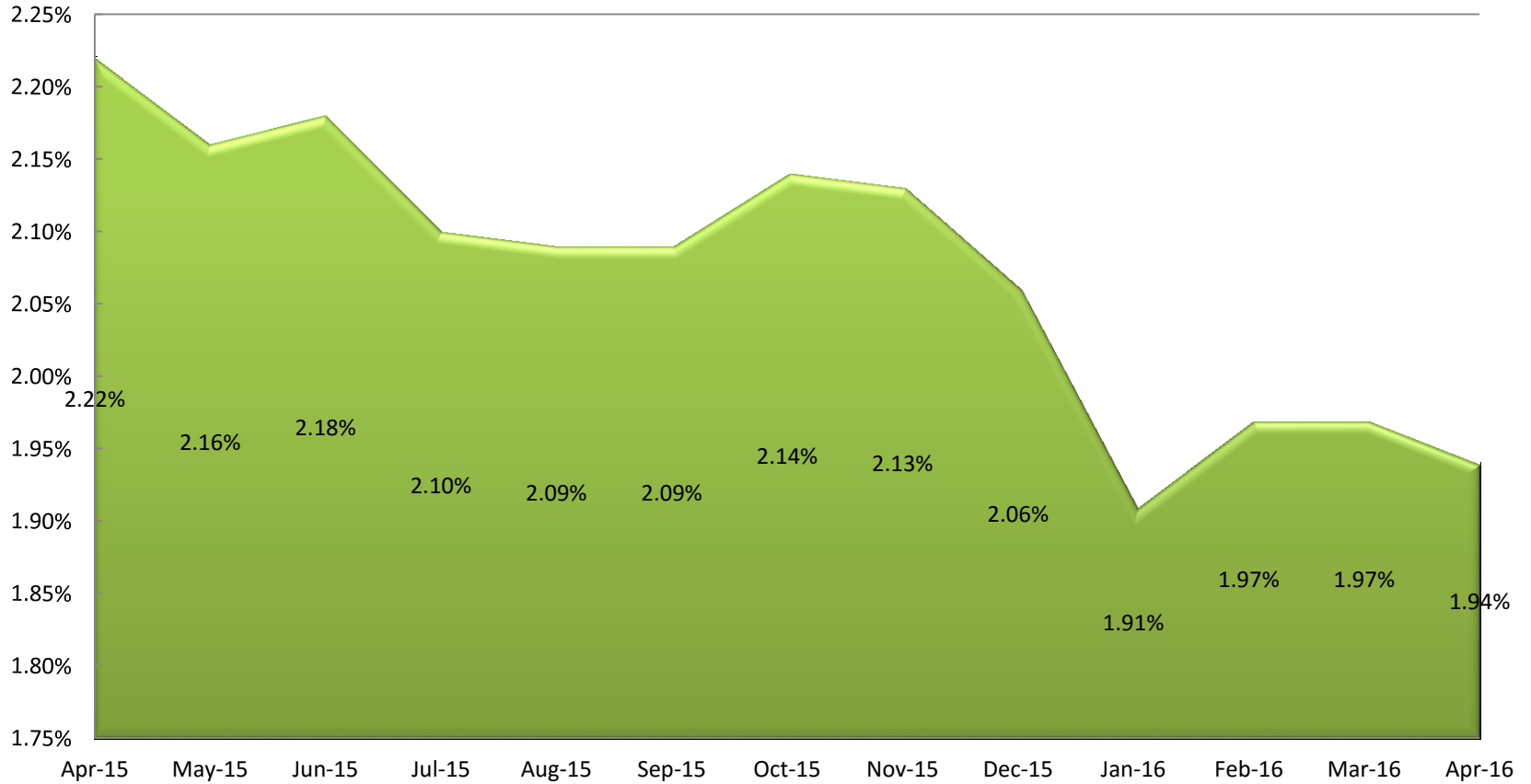


# Monthly E-Filing Submissions for April 2015 through April 2016

  - Correct and Resubmit
  - Do not resubmit
    - Leave submission in pending queue until Clerk updates status to Filed for Judicial Review where the filer can no longer update that submission
    - Delete submission from Pending Queue will be implemented October 2016

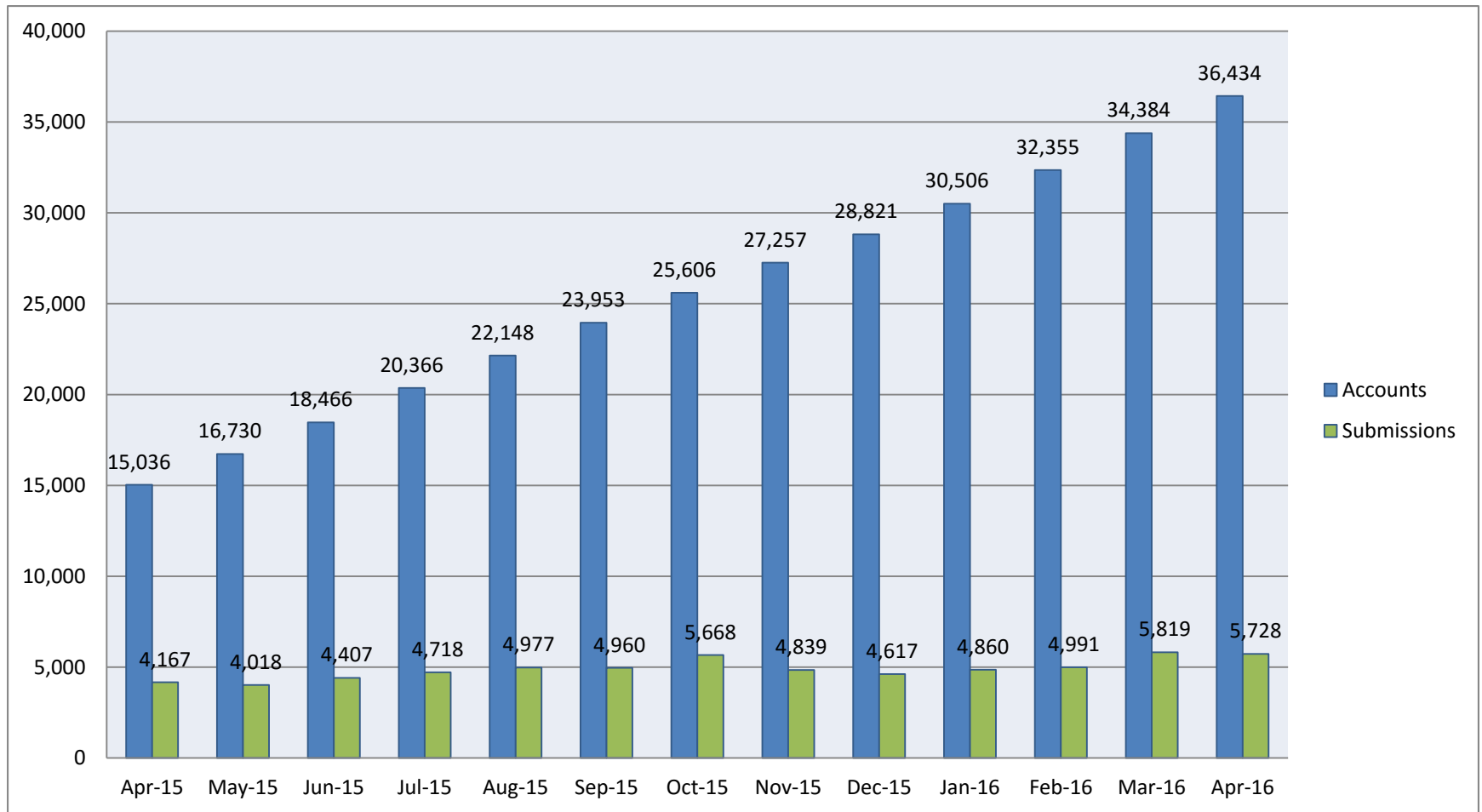
