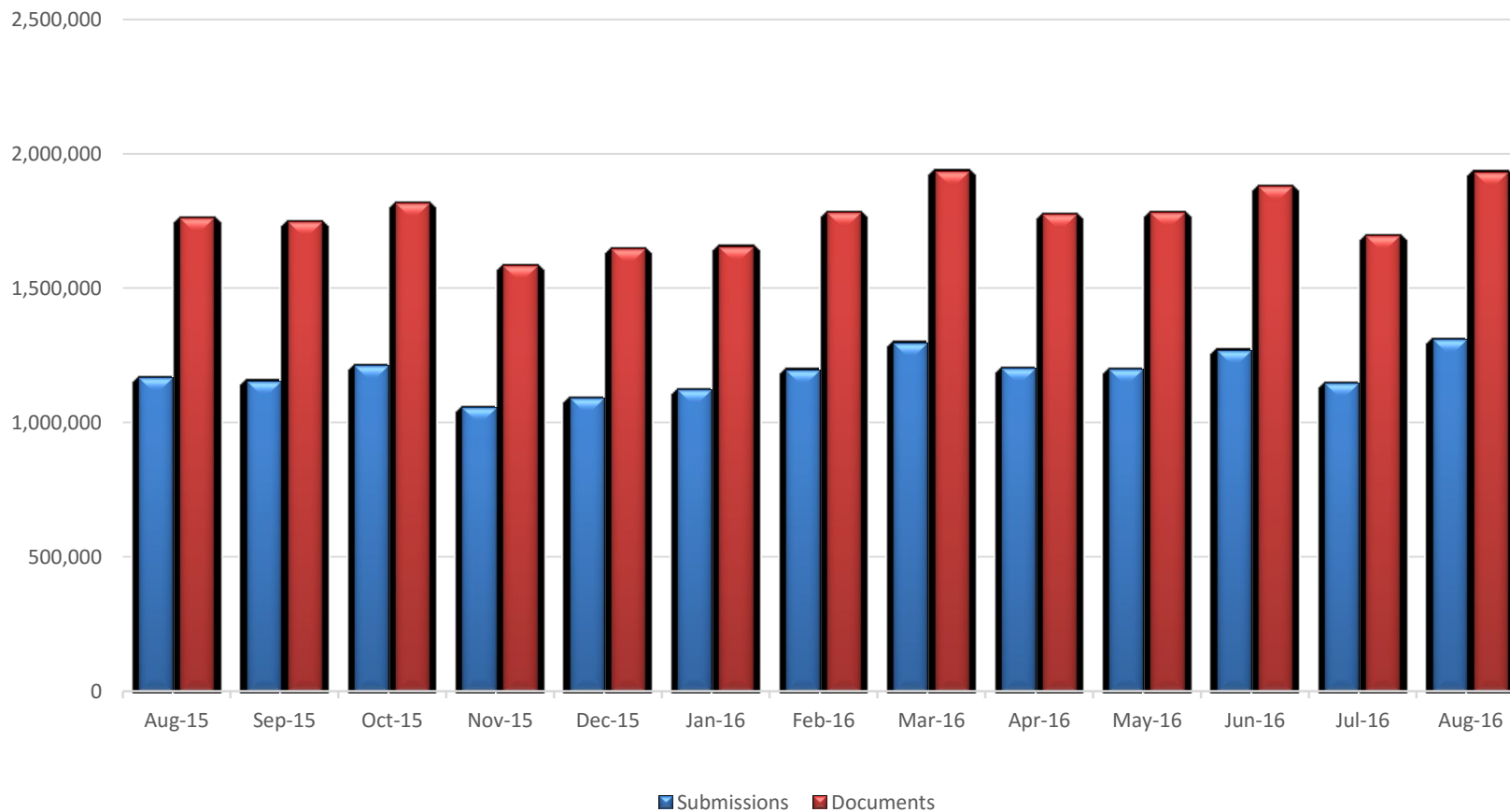

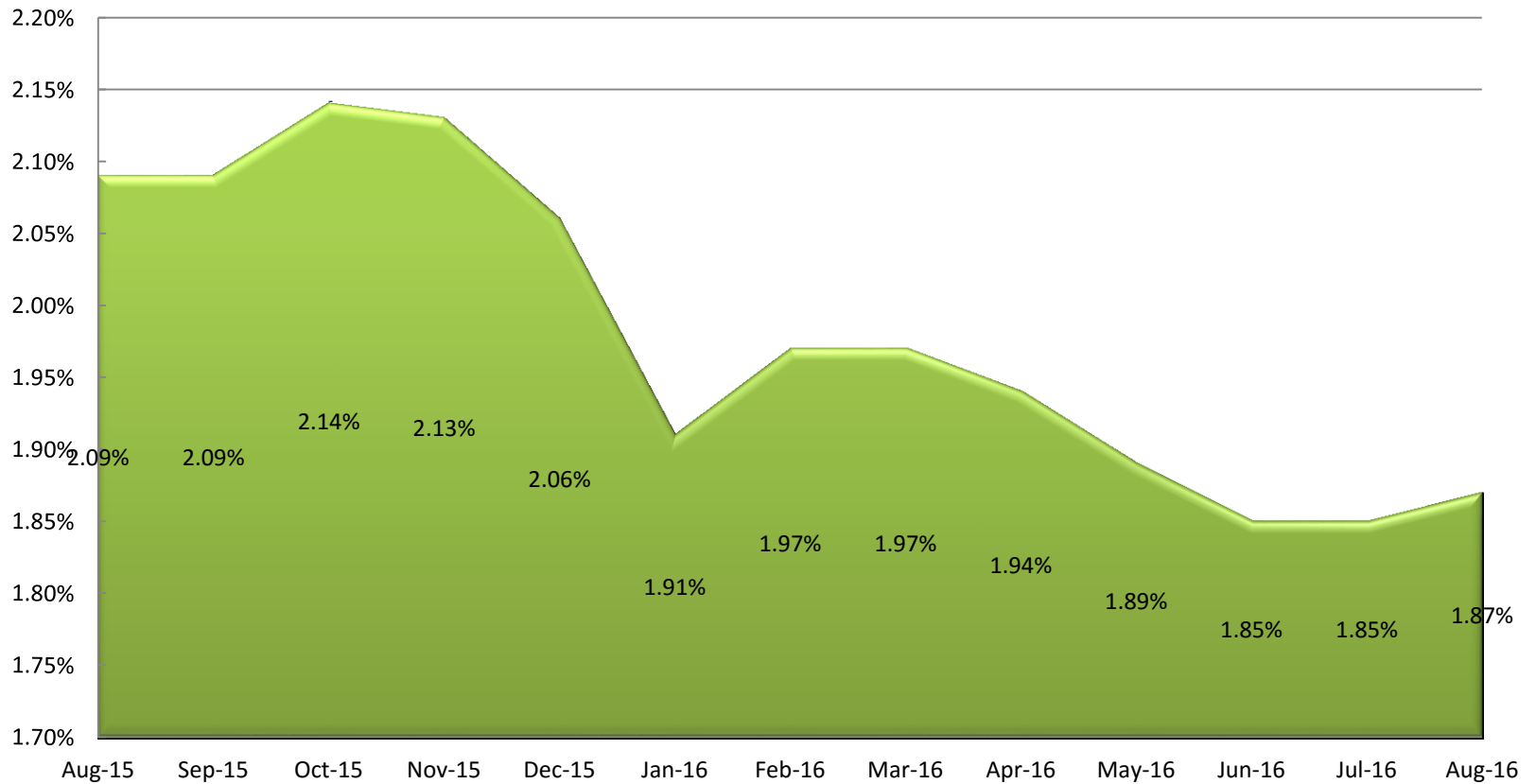


Monthly E-Filing Submissions for August 2015 through August 2016

 - Leave submission in pending queue until Clerk updates status to Abandoned Filing where the filer can no longer update that submission

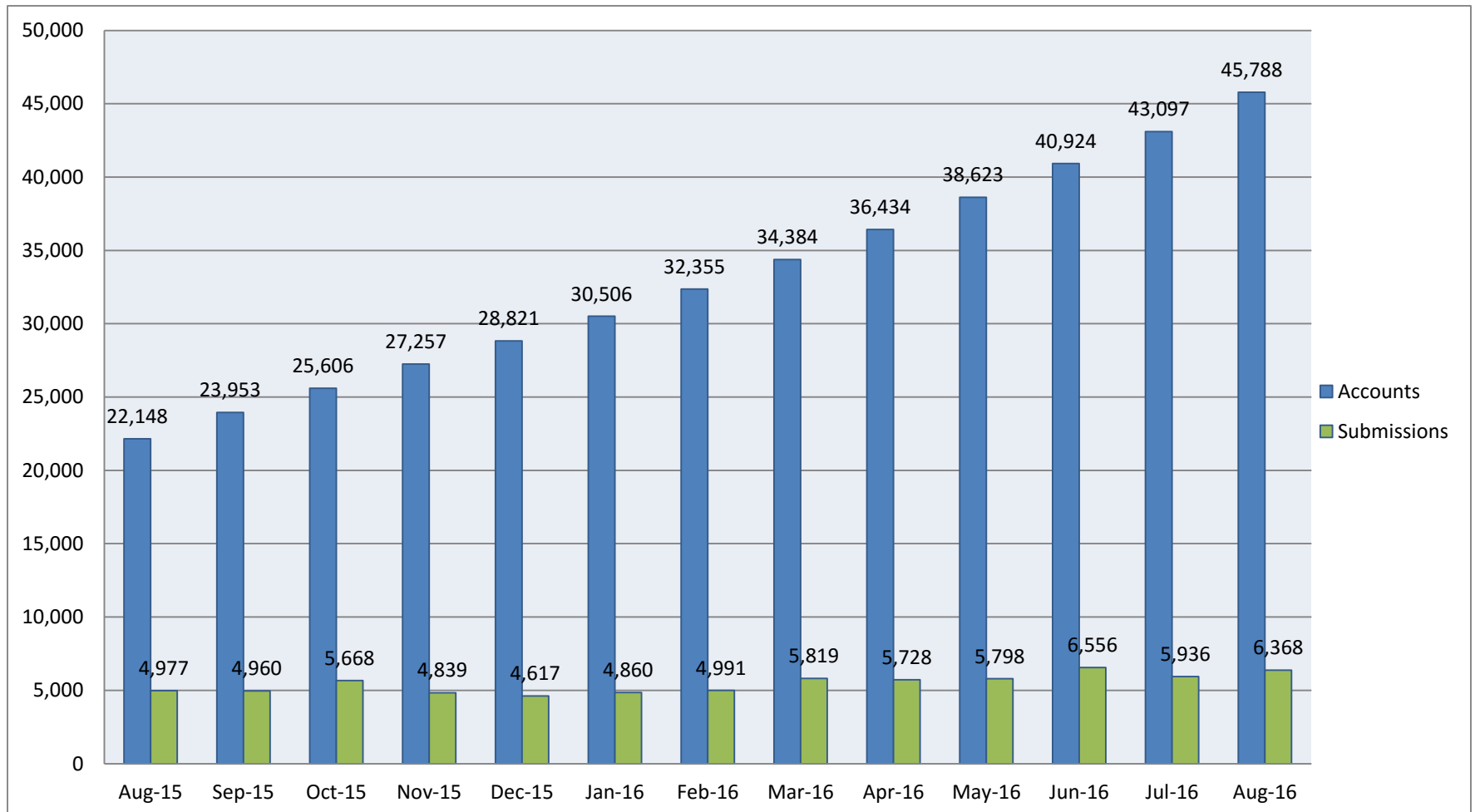
