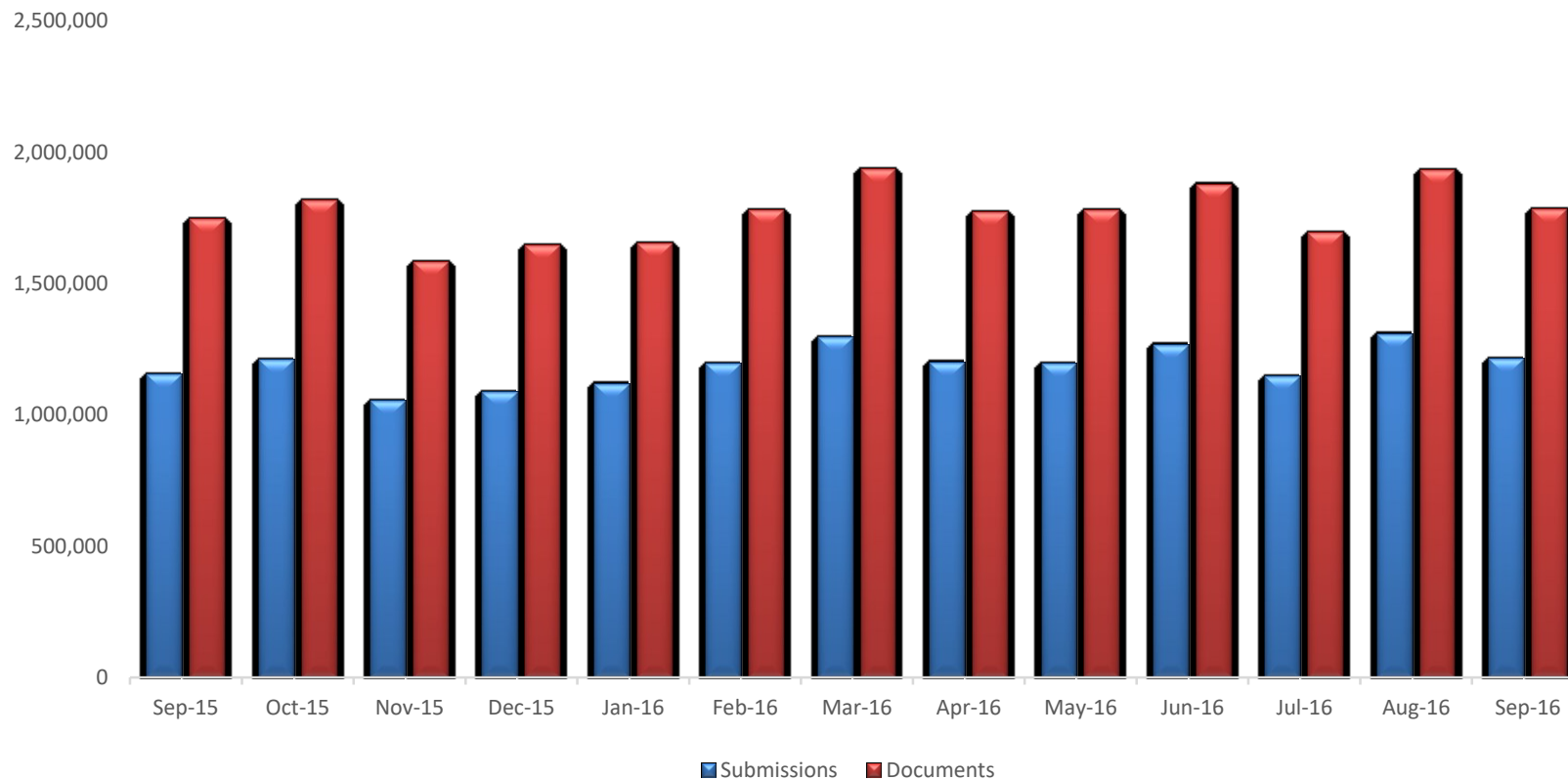

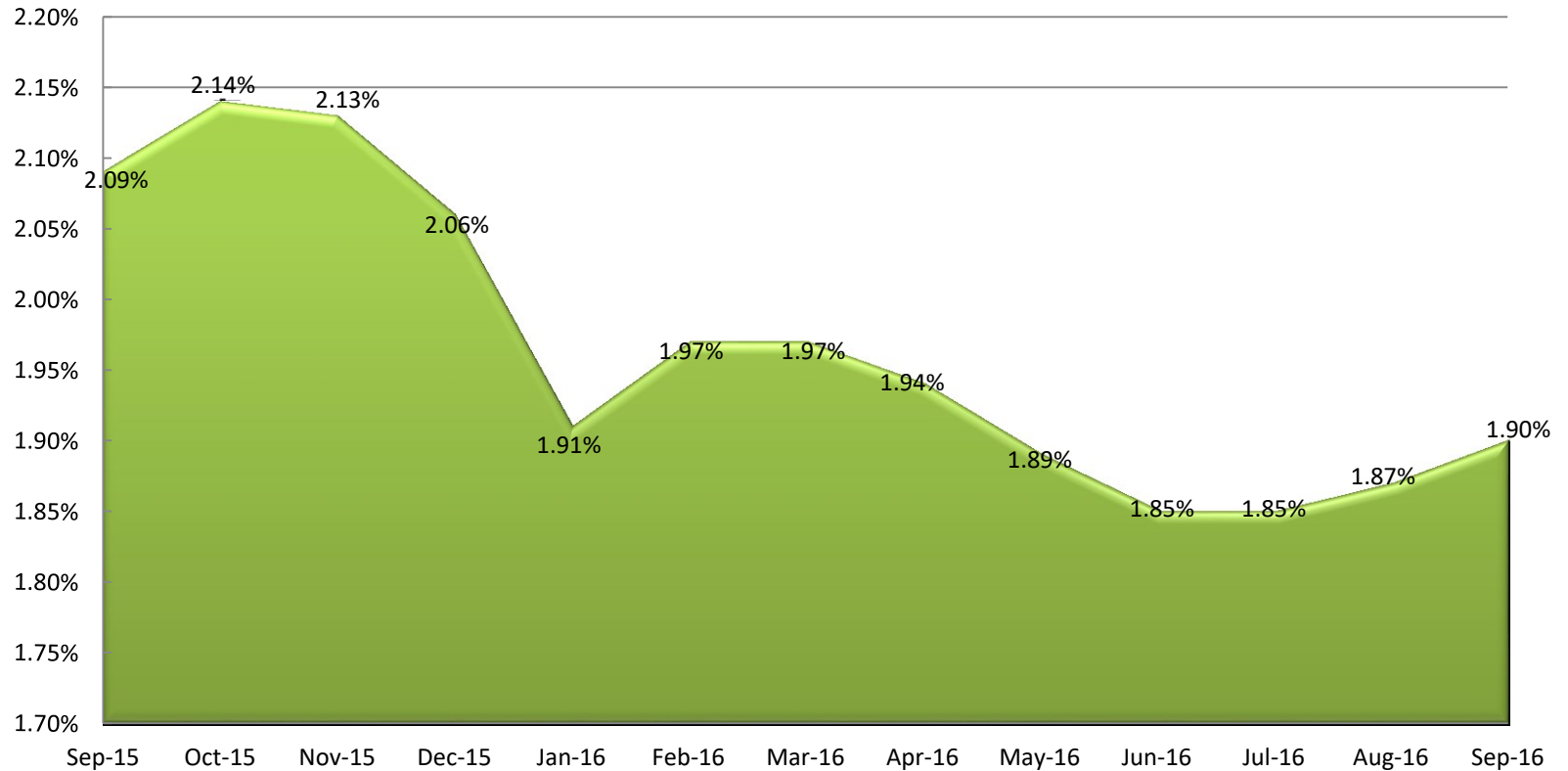


Monthly E-Filing Submissions for Sept. 2015 through Sept. 2016

 - Of the 23,004 submission returned for correction, 11,791 were corrected and resubmitted
 - Do not resubmit
 - Leave submission in pending queue until Clerk updates status to Abandoned Filing where the filer can no longer update that submission

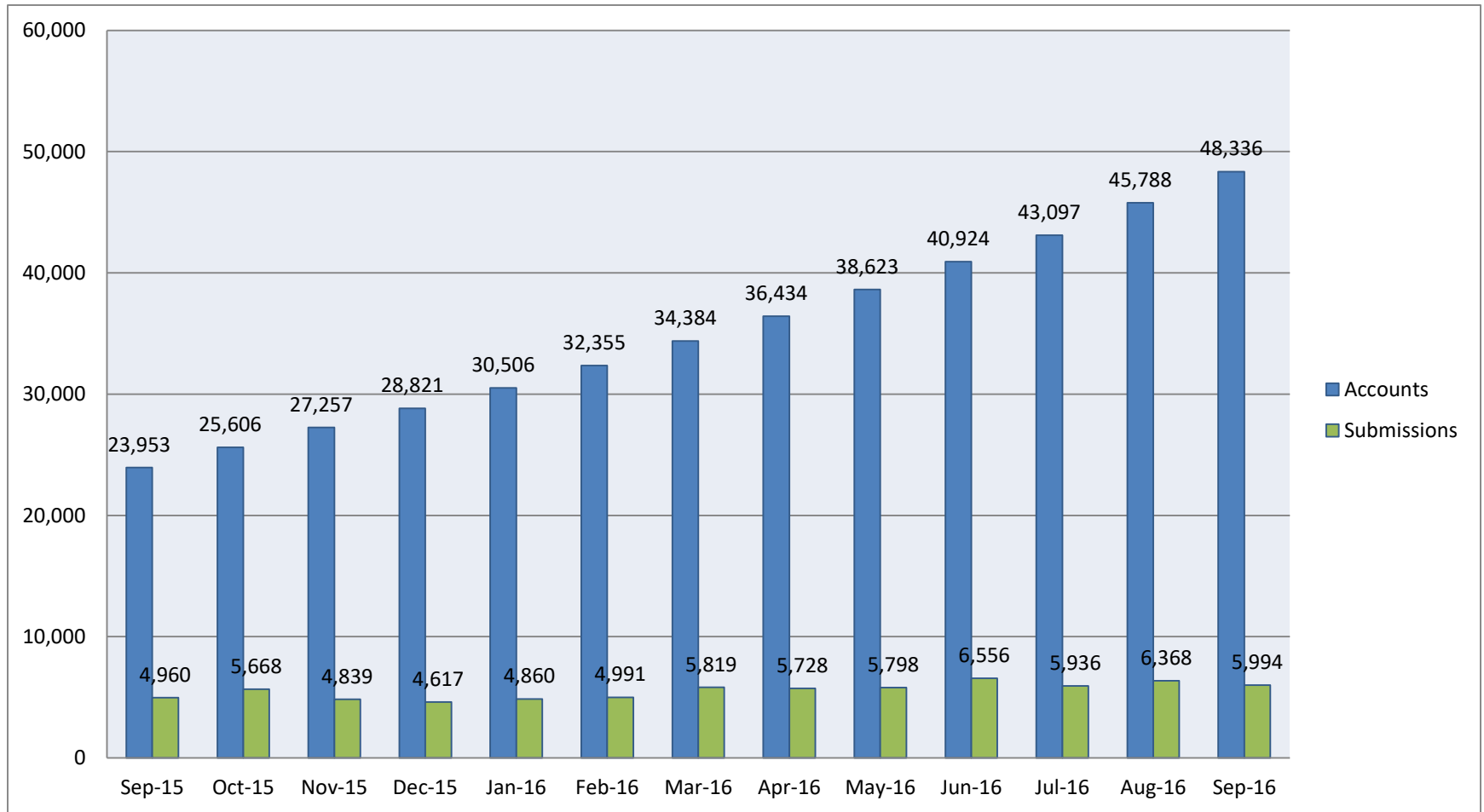
